Important things for Y3

Start and End of Day Procedures.

Our school day starts at 8:45 and learning tasks begin as soon as children come into class, so please ensure your child has good attendance and is punctual. Dismissal of children is at 3:15. Children are still working up to this point so please do not disturb them when waiting outside, especially when the door is open on hot days.

Water & Snacks

In order to promote healthy and clean living amongst our children, we require that all children bring in fruit for their break time snack. We do not permit chocolate bars, breakfast bars or any other non-fruit snack.

Children are expected to bring in their own water bottle with fresh water every day. Our school does not permit juice or fizzy drinks, only water. Fresh water is also available for all children in school, so they can top up when needed.

Music

Music lessons will be on Wednesdays for Year 3. Please ensure that your child brings in the instrument on Wednesday, as their participation is key to their learning as well as ensuring that the lesson is successful for al. Children must take their instruments home with them every Wednesday to allow them to practice at home.

We Love Learning / Wow days

We Love Learning is a fantastic opportunity offered in our school that allows members of the family to feel closer to the classroom. This will involve one parent or carer to come in to





school and participate in a lesson with their child. Be ready, because you may be getting involved in some Art, Drama, Cooking or any of the other lesson activities we partake in throughout Year 3. We will notify you closer to the time with more details about the lesson and activities.

We also have some exciting school trips and Wow Day workshops upcoming. Exact dates will be shared with you via ParentApp.

Equipment ...

School provides pens and pencils so children do not need to bring in pencil cases or any other equipment from home. Children must bring in a water bottle.

PE & Forest School

For Autumn 1 your child will need to wear their PE Kit & Tracksuit on Thursdays and Fridays. Forest School will be on Tuesdays. Your child will be allocated to either group A or B and the Forest School sessions will alternate between these groups each week.

Homework & Reading

Homework will be given out to the children in class on a Friday and will be due for the following Friday.

Year 3 each week will include – reading books (in bag every day), TT Rockstars or Maths worksheet, GPS or spelling worksheet.

How to help at home

Working alongside your child at home can be a very efficient and effective way to engage with/encourage their development.

Here are some of the ways in which you can support your child at home:

We encourage you to read daily with your child using their book from school. Talk to them about it, ask them questions, show them you are interested and they will be interested too. We advise that you read with them alongside their Reading Plus activities so that it is more of a fun activity than a task.

Engaging with your child about their learning can be massively beneficial to your child's attitude towards their own learning so ask them questions about their lessons so that they can feel that connection between home and school.

Additional Information

Our curriculum is always underpinned with a daily collective worship linked to a whole school theme. In R.E we follow the Archdiocese's Come and See Programme of study. Children explore scripture in different ways such as art, drama and writing. During these lessons they are encouraged to make links between the scripture and how they can apply it to their everyday lives. So far, Year 3 have been studying 'The Domestic Church' and exploring family life, allowing them to make links to their Catholic family as well.

Our English curriculum is based around a core text for each half term. This term we have started with 'Varjak Paw' which is engaging our pupils really well. Our English lessons are based around the exploration of the text through talk for writing and oracy to promote vocabulary.

At Christ the King we explore mathematical concepts through the 'Maths - No Problem' scheme. Children will work in a maths journal and a workbook. We focus on promoting the application of mathematical skills, developing skills of reasoning, and developing independent thinkers.

If you need to speak to your child's class teacher, please see them at the end of the school day for a short chat if they are available. The rest of the children in the class will need to be dismissed first. If you need a lengthier conversation, please arrange a meeting for a suitable time.
