## Afternoon prayer

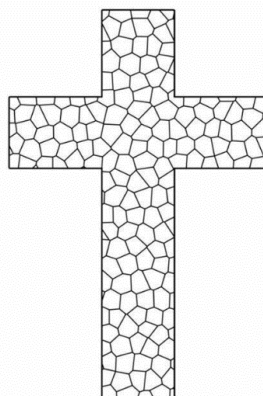
God our Father

## Hail Holy Queen

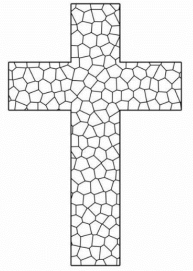
Hail Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy Hail our life, our sweetness

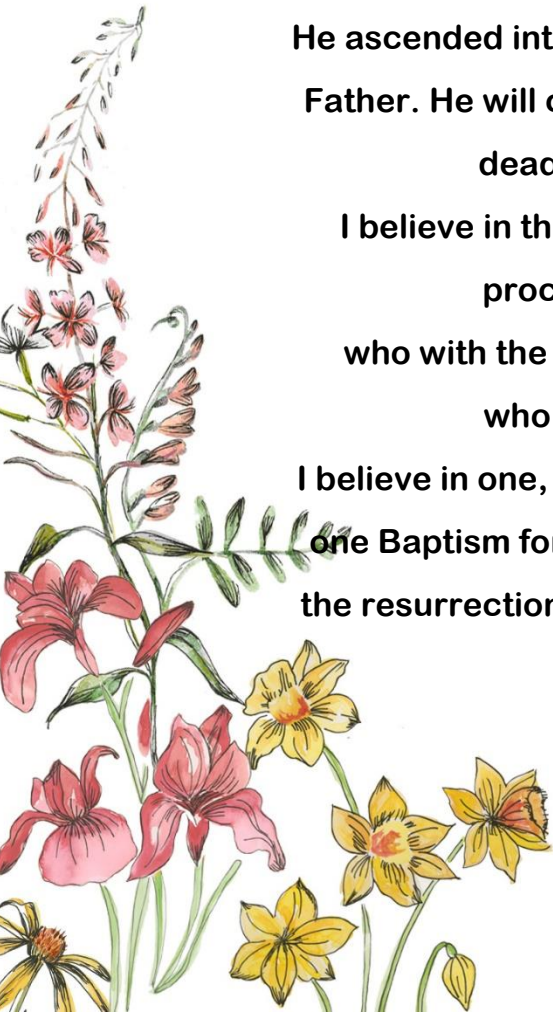
For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

Amen.



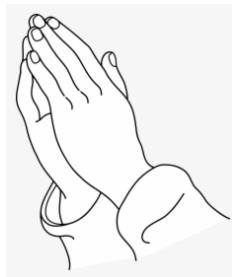


## Apostles' Creed
