Thursday 8 <sup>th</sup> December	Christmas Jumper Swap	3:15pm in the school hall – come and find a Christmas Jumper. Please send in donations of Christmas Jumpers beforehand.
Friday 9 <sup>th</sup> December 	Santa Dash & Boogie	Everyone is invited to join in our annual Santa Dash & Boogie. If you are able to donate we will be raising money for the Marie Curie Hospice in Woolton, a charity close to our hearts – there will be a collection bucket on the day for cash donations. Children are invited to wear something festive for the dash (Santa suits, Elves, reindeers, jumpers, something red or green – please don't go out and buy something especially for the day). Please remember children should wear trainers for the run and should be able to 'play out' in their outfits too.
Tuesday 13 <sup>th</sup> December 	Reception Nativity "Everyone loves a baby"	This will be performed in our school hall. Doors will open at 9:30am and the performance will start at 9:45am. Due to space, we can only allocate 2 tickets per child. Tickets will be given to children closer to the time and should be brought on the day to gain entry. Late comers will not be allowed in!
